HACC, Central Pennsylvania's Community College, has been informed that the Harrisburg Area Community College Education Association (HACCEA)—the union representing HACC's faculty—has declared that it will begin a strike on Monday, Nov. 3, 2025, at 12:01 a.m.

The College is deeply disappointed by this decision, as we believe a strike will directly and negatively affect our students—individuals who work diligently every day to achieve their educational and career goals. Despite this unfortunate development, HACC remains open and operational across all campuses. We remain committed to supporting our students and ensuring instructional continuity throughout this period.

Regarding **parking**, to ensure safety and smooth access to all campuses, designated parking areas will be in effect during the strike. Public Safety officers will be on site to assist and provide escorts as needed.

- Harrisburg Campus: Enter through Industrial Road, Gate 2, and park in the Facilities or West Lot.
- **Gettysburg Campus**: Use Entrance #3 and park in the Facilities Building lot or the overflow lots beside it.
- Lancaster Campus: Enter via the Pitney Road entrance and park in the North Lots.
- York Campus: Enter via Neu Road to Vogelsong Road and park on the west end of the Leader Lot.
- Lebanon Campus and Midtown Locations: No parking changes are necessary.
